- Festivals** — Japan is known for its timeless festivals and Princess offers the opportunity to see five different festivals across five different departures. Enjoy the marking of spring with Hanami (viewing of the cherry blossoms) during the Spring Flower Festival cruise or see the illuminated floats of Japanese warriors parade through the streets of Aomori during the Nebuta festival and witness the procession of 200 bamboo poles with lanterns weighing over 100 pounds all carried on the palms, foreheads, shoulders or backs of the celebrants during the Akita Kanto festival.
- UNESCO World Heritage Sites** — Many of the sights that you will have the opportunity to see in Japan and neighboring countries are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These include historic temples and shrines of ancient Kyoto, Korea's Silla Dynasty capital of Gyeongju, near Busan, and Aomori's Shirakami Sanchi Mountain area.
- Ryukyu Islands** — For the 2017 Japan season, Princess has expanded the offerings to Okinawa and Ishigaki, located in the southern island chain of Ryukyu. A world away from the mainland, these islands are a tropical paradise with their own dialect, unique cuisine and distinct culture.
- Diamond Princess®** — Japanese built, this is Diamond Princess' fourth season in the region with homeports of Tokyo (Yokohama) and Kobe. Onboard you'll experience the full colour and culture of the region with Diamond's distinctly Japanese offerings such as Kai Sushi, an authentic sushi bar, Izumi Spa, the largest open air Japanese bath at sea, and traditional music and entertainment.
